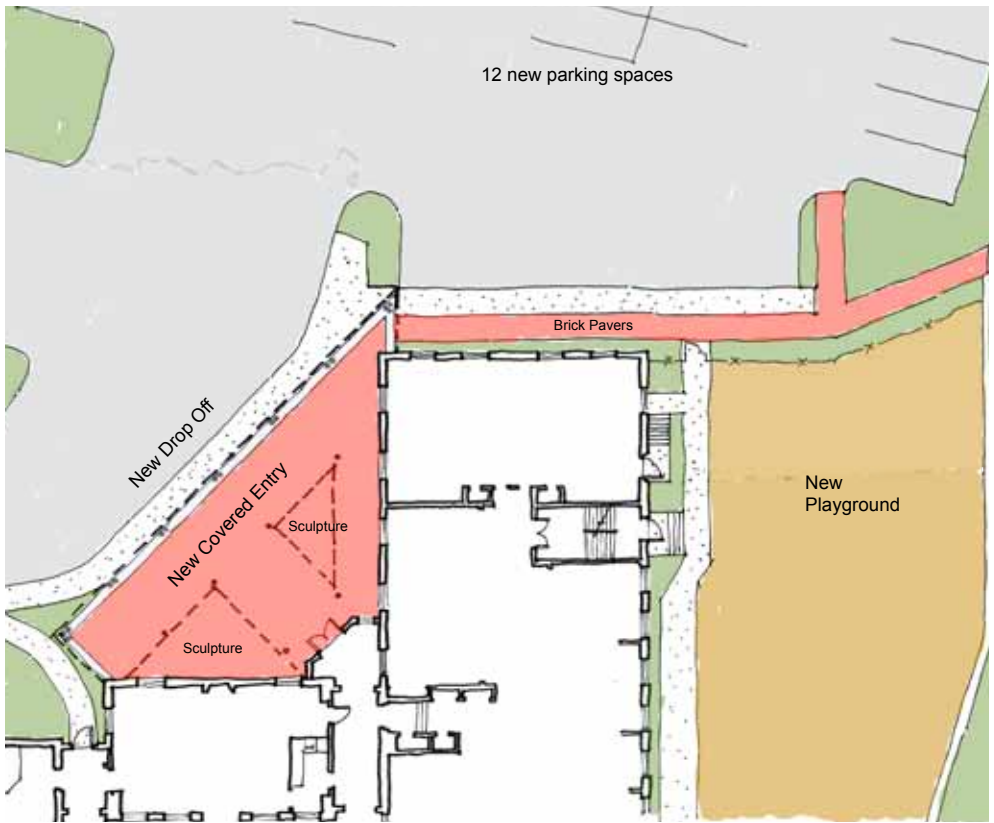




INFRASTRUCTURE
