

Meet the New Church Moderator

My name is Rachel Blair, and it is my pleasure to serve as Mayflower Congregational Church's Moderator this year. Having attended our church since 2014, I am particularly excited about the season ahead for all of us -- the horizon is bright! This September we have the fall picnic, the return of our Chancel and Youth Choirs, middle and high school youth groups starting up,

and this fall, a forthcoming Care Group opportunity, Deacon support for congregants, and more - what an exciting time to be here!

Taking stock of our current state, Rev. Dr. Shawn Bawulski has been with our congregation for one year. We are actively hiring an Associate Pastor, and we have continued excellence in our music leadership, youth programming, congregational events, and administrative structures. This fall will see new programming for our pre-K through 1st graders in Worship Center Sunday School led by volunteers trained by Paula Gaylord, a long-time MCC leader. Rachael Cooley and Abby Brooks will grow our 2nd-5th grade students on Sunday mornings in Bible Alive and Wednesdays during Midweek. Allison Houlihan, in partnership with our new Associate Pastor, will support our middle and high school students. We are planning opportunities for our youth to learn, serve, and grow in their knowledge of God. Musically speaking, Julia and Scott have Sunday morning music and fall concert series planned and Murry Idema along with Pastor Shawn will be leading our Deacons as they explore Prayer during the Sunday morning CE Hour and more.

In FY 23, our Strategic Planning Committee completed MCC's Strategic Plan, and this fall, Council will be reviewing this for implications to our operations, visioning, and next steps. Committees will be asked to set goals to keep MCC looking ahead. This coming winter, MCC will celebrate Advent and will go through a visioning process - stay tuned!

I am incredibly grateful to be part of this church community, and I am eager to listen, champion, and celebrate next steps for our church body. I hope this year ahead is an opportunity for all of us to deepen our faith, serve others, and love the Lord more fully.


